
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From Principal's Desk

Coordinator's insights






MAHARASHTRA DAY CELEBRATION

World Peace School proudly hosted the Toppers Felicitation Ceremony on 19th June, 2024 to honour the academic excellence of students from Grades 1 to 10.


Grade 10 toppers 🏆 –

- ✨ A heartfelt vote of thanks and birthday celebrations 🎉


The day concluded with the National Anthem and a spirit of mindfulness and unity.

ART INTEGRATION




To make learning fun and engaging, our young learners participated in an art-integrated activity designed to help them recognize the letter 'A'.


🏆 Shivtej Shines at the National Level! 🥊

करशील सर्व अडचणीवर सहज मात.




