PARENT ORIENTATION



The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has introduced a new policy allowing Class 10 students to take board exams twice a year, starting from February 2026. The two exams are.

- First Exam (Mandatory): Held in February, covering the full year's syllabus.
- Second Exam (Optional): Held in May, allowing students to improve their scores in up to three subjects.

CBSE Class 10 Two-Exam Policy (From Feb 2026)

- Two Board Exams per Year:
 - First Exam (Mandatory): February–March, full syllabus.
 - Second Exam (Optional): May, for improving scores in up to 3 subjects (Science, Maths, Social Science, Languages).
- Passing Criteria: Minimum 33% overall (internal + board marks). Failures enter the Improvement Category and can take the second exam.
- Eligibility:
 - First Exam: All Class 10 students.
 - Second Exam: Only those seeking improvement.
- Exam Pattern: Theory – 80 marks, Internal Assessment – 20 marks (once per year).
 - Mathematics: 5 (Periodic) + 5 (Practical) + 10 (Portfolio)
 - Science: 10 (Periodic) + 5 (Practical) + 5 (Portfolio)
 - Social Science: 10 (Pen-paper & Multiple) + 5 (Lab) + 5 (Portfolio)
- Results & Certificates:
 - First exam results uploaded to DigiLocker for Class 11 admissions.
 - Final certificates issued after the second exam.








Culmination Event


The presence of grandparents added warmth and blessings, making the day truly memorable. The program concluded with a vote of thanks and a cheerful interaction, leaving smiles on every face.






Clay Modelling Competition






Poster Making Competition
